#### BASIC ANIMAL CONTROL LAWS

Please remember we have City Ordinances to regulate animals, such as:

"every dog or cat (4) months or older must be vaccinated for Rabies and be licensed by the City of LR (the animal must wear the license on a collar or harness at all times)..."

"...Residents may not exceed four (4) dogs and four (4) cats per household unless a kennel permit is obtained."

"...all dogs must be confined on the owner's property by a fence, pen or tethering to an approved trolley system..."

"Individuals within the City of Little Rock who are owners of certain breeds (American Pit Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier, Staffordshire Terrier) must be registered at the Little Rock Animal Village..."

"[It is] unlawful for any person to allow an animal within the person's control to defecate on public property or on private property of another person..."

#### **Community Events & Programs**

#### **Common Areas**

Our tennis courts are currently open Monday through Saturday 9am - 9pm and on Sunday from 1pm - 6pm. The gym is currently open Monday - Friday from 8am - 6pm. No more than 2 are allowed in the gym at a time. Please call our office to check availability before coming. Our pools are open Tuesday through Saturday 12-8pm and Sunday 1-6pm. Please see the website for complete and current list of Covid -19 restrictions. Please note, OC ID is required to use any facility. This applies to members of all ages with the exception of ages 5 and under.

Bathroom facilities, playgrounds and other high exposure surfaces are being sanitized daily. Please continue to use your best judgment in playing or allowing children to play at OC facilities.

#### FIREWORKS PROHIBITED

Fireworks are illegal inside the city limits. Violators should be immediately reported to LRPD. Furthermore, fireworks are a direct violation of the Otter Creek Bill of Assurance. Violators will be cited and potentially fined. Please remember that we have veterans who live within the Association. We must show our veterans respect by not using fireworks within this community. Please ensure children are respectful to neighbors and, that they adhere to the law and BOA.

#### **Yard Signs Prohibited**

Please remember that yard signs are strictly prohibited under the Otter Creek Bill of Assurance. The only exception is for signs advertising your property for sale or rent. These may not exceed 5 square feet.

#### **Using Facilities With Social Distancing...**

Many have expressed gratitude for our facilities being open to our members and for our efforts in keeping our facility sanitized and safe for all. There is no perfect formula that will fit every member's desires during this time. Our goal and responsibility are to open and maintain the facilities for our members. While we are working harder than ever to create a safe and sanitary environment for those who choose to use our facilities during this time, and while outdoor activities have been deemed to be the safest activities, we must ask that each member determine for themselves what is safe and right for their own household. Please, do not come to the facilities if you are or have recently been sick or have been exposed to someone who was or is sick. Please do not come or allow children to come if there are health conditions that may create an immune deficiency. Those who do choose to use facilities, please talk to children about keeping a 6' distance between them and unrelated children at all times. Members will be asked to leave the facilities if social distancing is not adhered to. If we work together, we can keep our distance and still enjoy the outdoors and this beautiful community together.
